Pleasant for their hospitality. They were incredibly gracious and helpful all throughout the organizational process. I would also be remiss if I didn't profusely thank board members Liz H. and Erin for taking on this huge project, and the many other volunteers and board members who pitched in along the way to make it happen.



Our Rummage Sale was held on July 23-27.

Thanks to everyone who helped out and donated. Without your donations, we could not have done it.

We were able to raise approximately \$4,000 for the rector's fund!







Fabulous News from People Helping People

The MP Area Community Foundation (MPACF) awarded PHP a remarkable \$10,000 grant in its most recent grant cycle. The grant application was titled "One Sandwich at a Time: Reducing Food Insecurities in Isabella County," and the award will cover the cost of 1,052 hearty deli lunches. That's a lot of sandwiches, enough to provide a hearty deli lunch for FIVE families of four for 52 weeks.

But that's not all ...

The Donna Parr Living Trust has just designated \$40,000 to PHP for its newly established endowed fund at the MPACF. Thanks to the Donna Parr's family, the new PHP endowment is now fully funded and is, therefore, eligible to receive 4% annual distributions, enough to cover the cost of approximately 200 sandwiches.

The Isabella Community Soup Kitchen (ICSK) remains closed on Sundays, with no other social service agencies serving food on the same day. PHP helps to fill this serious social services gap in Isabella County.

June's minutes will be published in the September Evangel as Vestry did not meet in July.

Through the first six months of 2025, income remains down. The next six months will be very challenging for our parish to achieve a balanced budget. Through the first six months of 2024, income was down only \$1,911 compared to \$14,664 this year.



The Singing Church


Starting the August 24,
